We prefer that you use the age calculator (for accuracy), but it is not required; you will still be allowed to manually enter age. b. To use the calculator, you must first enter an Arrival Date. (Age is calculated from this field and birth date) c. To using age calculator, click on "Calculate From Birthdate". A data entry field appears. Click on this field, and a drop-down calendar will appear. d. Select the following in this order: Month (a menu item), Year (a menu item), and Day (on the calendar). Immediately after you click the day, the age will automatically be calculated and entered. Click Save to move on to next tab. Birthdate will not be saved. e. The system will flag a warning if the age is under 18 years. However, you will still be allowed to close the record. It's just a warning. f. Birthdate may be entered manually (MM/DD/YYYY format). When finished entering the birthdate, click the "Calc" button to calculate the age. (Do NOT hit "ENTER" on your keyboard, as this will simply save your form without saving the age.) Click Save to move on to next tab.
